### **Vision:**

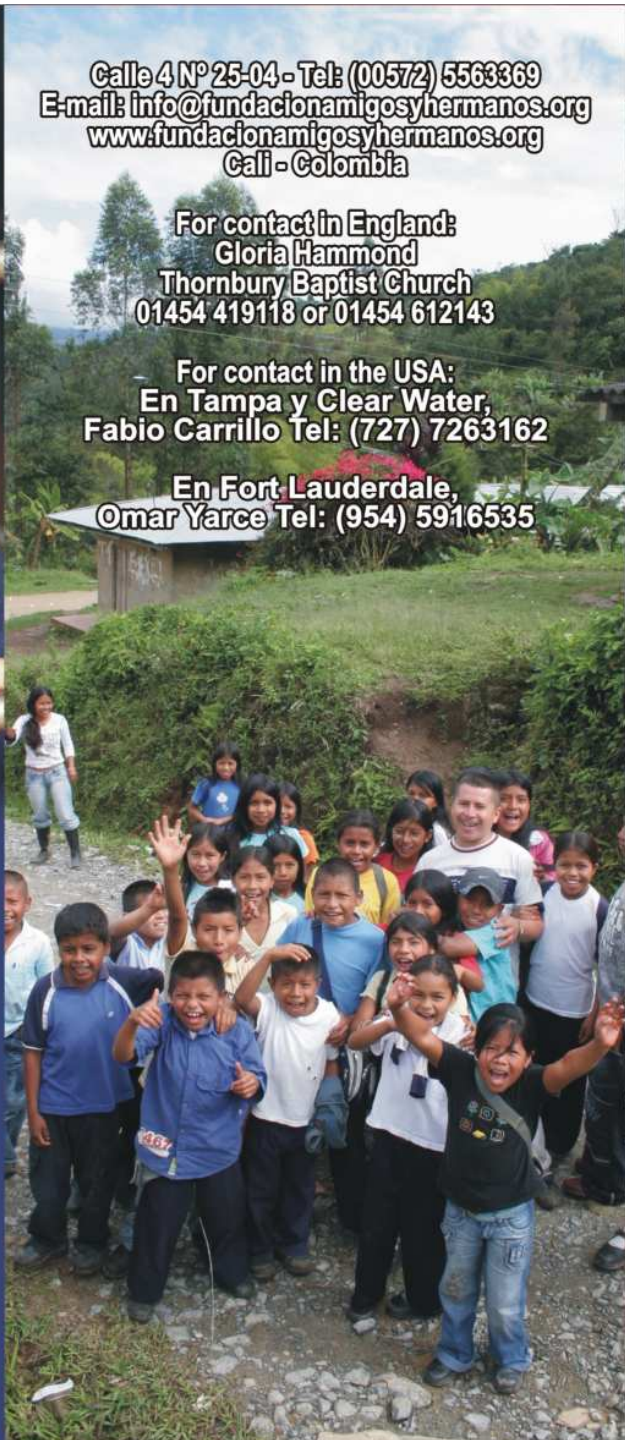

## Who are we?

We are a team of volunteers and founding partners who work for the unity and fraternity of 'Amigos y Hermanos' of all nations and denominations. We do this to bring spiritual, moral and social aid to the poor, the widowed, orphans, and foreigners.



## ¿What do we believe?

We believe in social evangelism, where we serve God and our fellow man following in the footsteps of Jesus Christ in love, forgiveness and mercy.

## What do we do?

We are involved with the International Festival for Peace in Colombia (FESTIPAZ).

We work towards forgiveness, reconciliation and goodwill between the different factions involved in the armed conflict in our country. On the first Saturday of every December we celebrate the National day of Prayer and Reconciliation all over Colombia.

## Arts and the Mass Media

We have made documentaries about the areas we work in, a video about our foundation, and a series called 'Copito', a puppet is used to teach children Christian principles and values.



## Children at risk

We work in the marginalized urban areas of Aguablanca, Jarillon del Rio Cauca (Hormiguero district) Golondrinas, Montebello, Palmira, La Isla, Siloé, Juanchito, el Vallado and Leticia (the Amazonas).



We sponsor children who need education, placing the majority in Christian schools. The 'Amigos y Hermanos' Foundation search out marginalised children, victims of violence and poverty, domestic mistreatment, neglect and rape.

## Black Communities

Black communities living in the Pacific jungle that have been seriously affected by armed conflict especially the guerilla movement. We are carrying out a project of spiritual guidance for the rebuilding of their lives. We are building a church and a dining hall for the use of all the community. We support a school for many children and we are planning to create domestically managed agricultural land and to provide access to drinking water.



## Indigenous Communities

The Nasa Yuwe, the Awa and the Guambianos, found in Cauca, Huila, and Nariño departments.

We carry out projects of spiritual and material support for the rebuilding of their families. Many problems result from displacement caused by the confrontation between the army and rebel groups.



## Caring for Children with Aids

We support children of parents carrying HIV.

We provide them with spiritual guidance, food and clothes and other necessities.



## New Projects

We are opening two homes in Cali, a drop-in home in El Calvario district, and a permanent home. The aim of these two homes is to help minors and orphans who are in imminent danger from drug addiction and prostitution.
